In addition, the school continues to receive additional donations from individuals and corporations alike. All of that comes together to bridge the financial gap, allowing your child the educational and spiritual benefits you undoubtedly see and feel.

In that vein, we strive to adjust the financial commitment for our families only so much as is truly necessary to ensure such continued excellence. For the 2012-2013 school year, tuition rates will increase as follows:

- Kindergarten – \$175
- Elementary – \$200
- Middle School – \$285
- High School – \$300

To put this into context, as a whole, this is actually below the current inflation rate of 3.9%. Certainly with the cost of goods and services continuing to rise dramatically, we all know that the school cannot operate without tuition increases keeping pace with inflation each year. However, God has been so good and the budget has been managed well, which allowed the Board to keep the increases to a bare minimum this year. We believe that the school's financial security is protected and we have struck the best balance between HCA maintaining its current status of excellence, while being sensitive to the continuing economic climate of our county, state and country.

Please join with us as we press forward with Christian education, that we may make a change in this world for Jesus Christ.
